
FILM CATALOGUE 2018/2019 FILM AGENCY NORTH MACEDONIA FILM AGENCY



The activities of the North Macedonia Film Agency in recent years have focused primarily on supporting the production of films. Other activities have included the organization of film festivals and the promotion of Macedonian films at international festivals and events. We have also continued to support international cooperation and the development of film professionals.

This was a truly exciting year for Macedonian cinematography. A Macedonian short film was among five films selected to launch the 2019 Cannes Directors' Fortnight as part of a collaborative project called the 'South East European Factory', which brings together 5 countries from the region.

We are especially proud of *Honeyland* winning three awards at the Sundance Festival, as well as the success of *God Exists, Her Name Is Petrunya*, which was screened at an official competition in Berlin and picked up two awards.

Our presence at two of the largest, most prestigious and internationally renowned film festivals has contributed not only to the international acclaim of our country but also testifies to the fact that our country possesses skilled directors with vast creative potential.

Throughout this period the Agency has been drafting a new version of the Law on the Film Industry and actively developing a new and comprehensive strategy to enhance the quality of national cinematography and increase its competitive advantage in the regional and wider framework. This strategy includes activities for developing the domestic film culture, with an emphasis on tapping into the talents of the younger population, while developing a system for supporting national production and co-production and services for recording completely foreign productions in the country. Support will be provided as part of this strategy for expanding distribution and marketing, while activities will be undertaken for developing existing professional film workers and for addressing the insufficient supply of film professionals.

In this new strategy and in all other activities planned for the coming years, the North Macedonia Film Agency will place special emphasis on nurturing women directors and encouraging new women directors to conceive and initiate original and innovative films.

At the same time, greater openness and logistical support will be provided for foreign producers interested in shooting their films at attractive locations in North Macedonia, with stimulus provided by the production incentive programme. In particular, the Agency has been focused on boosting the country's film production tax incentive, increasing it from 20% to 30% as an effective measure to bring about significant benefits for the national film industry and the economy.

Innovation is a top priority in the Agency's strategy and one that will achieved by encouraging new film professionals and new ideas and talents, with activities to increase the quality of Macedonian cinematography, investing in new forms and models of promotion. As well as deepening our already established cooperation with existing partners, the Agency will seek new forms of cooperation that complement mutual work, all of which will help achieve new and greater successes.

The Agency is strongly committed to providing continuous support for the film industry and contributing to its further development, leading to a positive transformation that will put North Macedonia on the map of countries known for producing original films.

A person who becomes a dervish must be a man with a clean and honest soul.

NORTH MACEDONIA FILM AGENCY FUNDING SCHEMES

NORTH MACEDONIA FILM AGENCY AIMS AND GOALS

The NMFA has the following aims and goals:

- to provide annual financial support for North Macedonia's national film production, international co-productions and national film festivals, as well as other projects for promoting and improving the film industry;

- to provide continuous support of script development;

- to provide support for young film professionals participating in international film workshops, training programmes and summer schools, etc.;

- to organize international events providing opportunities for film professionals from North Macedonia to connect with each other on film co-production, distribution, promotion, sales, etc.;

- to promote Macedonian cinematography at renowned international film festivals and events;

- to promote Macedonia as an attractive filming location with favourable conditions.

SERVICES OFFERED BY THE NORTH MACEDONIAN FILM AGENCY

The North Macedonian Film Agency, as the only national institution for the support of the film industry in North Macedonia, provides:

- information on funding schemes and all necessary documents and rules for application;

- links between international film professionals and local producers and film-makers;

- information and help for foreign teams visiting and shooting in North Macedonia on state institutions and bodies;

- information, assistance and logistical support for those interested in visiting locations in North Macedonia;

- all other services within the scope of the film industry.



CO-PRODUCTION OPPORTUNITIES

The North Macedonian Film Agency provides public funding for minority co-productions with Macedonian participation.

Eligible genres: fiction, documentary, animation, short

Calls for entries: open annual call

Submission deadlines: February/March and August/September

Deadline for decision: April and October

Nature of funding: Selective

Who can apply: National production companies

Main selection criteria: originality, authenticity and script quality; success of film director and producer; 50% of financing already in place; participation of Macedonian artistic and technical staff; official coproduction under either a bilateral treaty or the European Convention on Cinematographic Co-Production

Co-production share: a maximum of 20% of the total budget Spending in the country %: min. 80%

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FILM PRODUCTION INCENTIVE PROGRAMME REBATE FOR FILM AND TV

In accordance with the Film Industry Law, which entered into force in 2014, the North Macedonia Film Agency stimulates investments in film and television projects using the right to refund invested funds. This programme is available to international and local filmmakers in the form of a rebate on qualifying local spend.

Qualifying production format: feature films, documentaries, animated films, television films and TV series.

Eligible expenditures: Costs of goods and services purchased in North Macedonia and wages paid to Macedonian tax residents for services (both cast and crew) carried out in North Macedonia. The cash rebate is calculated on the basis of the total qualifying expenditure, including value added tax, and is paid directly to the applicant's Macedonian bank account.

Call for entries: Open annual call

Priority of evaluation: First-come, first-serve basis

Eligible applicants: The applicant must be a Macedonian producer, co-producer or production service provider (who has made and publicly exhibited at least one feature film). The Macedonian partner provides the full range of production services, including location scouting, scheduling, budgeting, casting and crewing, and takes full responsibility for all production services carried out in North Macedonia.

Requirement: Minimum local spend per project of 100,000 EUR in MKD equivalent, according to the middle exchange rate of the National Bank of Republic of Macedonia on the day when the request for rebate is submitted.

Deadline for submission: The complete application must be submitted to the Macedonian Film Agency at least 15 days prior to the start of the filming of the project.

Body in charge of the procedure: Commission for Establishing the Right to Refund. Evaluating the application: The commission evaluates the application within 15 days of the request being submitted.

Net benefit: Will be made upon completion of production, submission of audited accounts and evidence that all requirements have been met.
